

ALBERTA TRAFFIC SAFETY FUND - FALL GRANTS AVAILABLE

Alberta Traffic Safety Fund grants are available to Alberta communities for traffic safety initiatives. The purpose of the fund is to stimulate and support local collaborative action that enhances traffic safety awareness and reduces the frequency and severity of motor vehicle related injuries within Alberta communities.

Up to \$400,000 will be available for the 2010/2011 fiscal year of which \$300,000 will be used for larger grants and \$100,000 for smaller grants.

TWO LEVELS OF GRANTS ARE AVAILABLE:

- ❖ Larger Grants (>\$5,000-\$17,000) and;
- ❖ Smaller Grants (≤\$5,000).

Smaller grants are accepted and reviewed on an ongoing first come, first served basis.

A consultation with the Grant Program Coordinator prior to the submission of a larger or smaller grant application **is required**. This consultation will determine the sponsoring organization and project's eligibility and whether the project conforms to the fund guidelines.
