

# rear-facing safety seats

Read your vehicle  
and safety seat  
instructions.

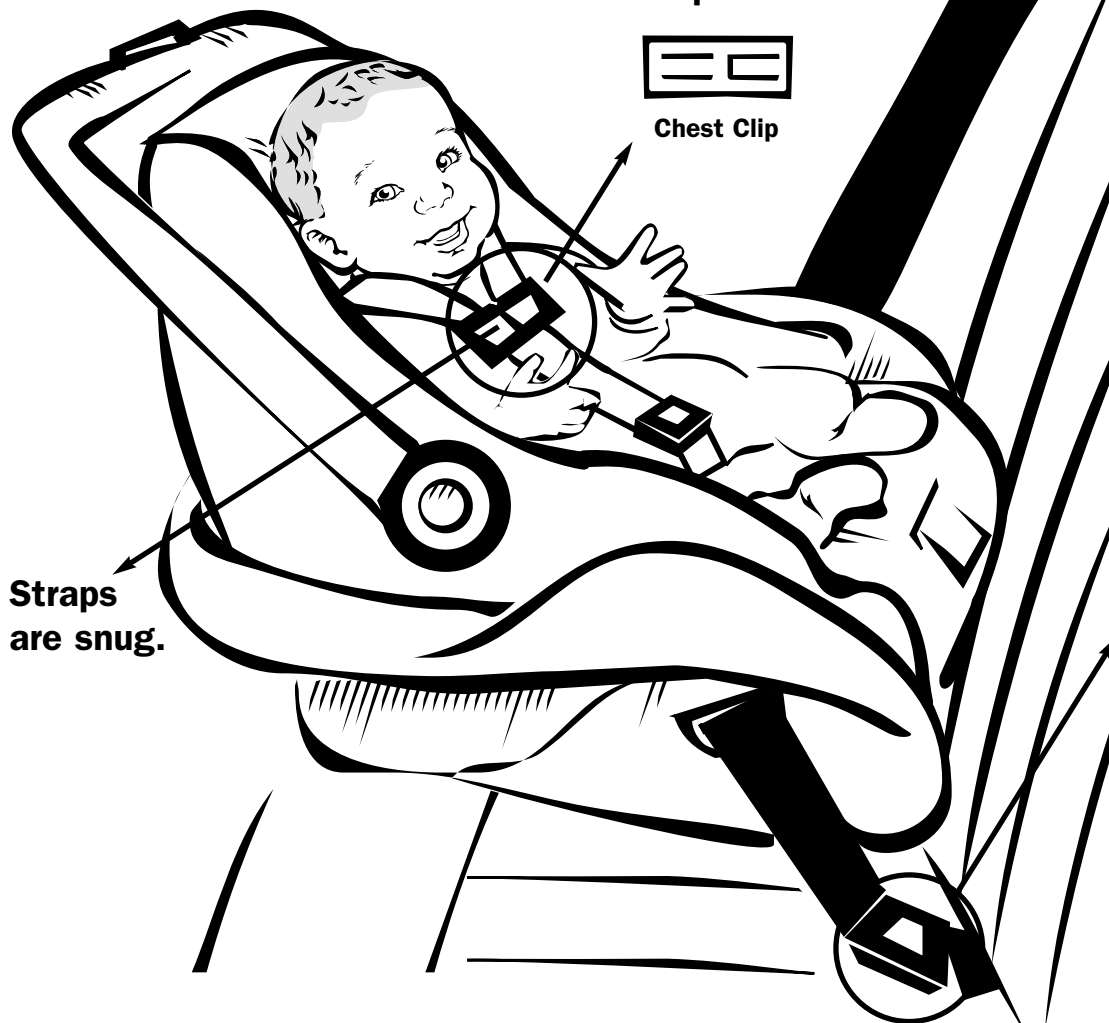
Birth to 1 year and 20 pounds (9 kilograms)

Babies must be in a rear-facing seat when in a vehicle. **It is the law in Alberta.** It is safest for babies to stay rear-facing until they are at least one year of age and weigh 20 pounds (9 kilograms).

Chest clip is  
at the baby's  
armpit level.

Straps  
are snug.

**NEVER** place  
a rear-facing  
seat in front  
of an air  
bag.

Seat belt is  
buckled  
tight to hold  
the seat in  
the vehicle.
