FLASHING RED MEANS STOP!

It's a fact that...

School buses are a common sight on Alberta roads and their constant presence makes it easy to be forgetful of what to do when you encounter one.

It's a fact that...

The greatest danger to students and others is while loading and unloading school buses.

Do your part for school bus safety

Follow these important rules of the road:

- Alternating flashing yellow or amber lights mean a bus is slowing down to stop. Do the same.
- No matter which direction motorists are coming from, they must STOP whenever approaching a stopped school bus with activated flashing red lights — unless the bus is on the opposite side of a divided highway.



Share the road safely with the yellow bus.

Know and obey the rules.
